The parent, guardian, or other person having custody of a child to whom the textbooks are issued, will be liable for any loss, abuse, or damage in excess of that which would result from normal use of the such textbook.

All textbooks must be returned to the issuing school when promoted, transferred, or when attendance is terminated.
